

What do I need to be successful in Credit Recovery?

1. Students should be self-motivated and self-directed, desiring to complete the program.
2. Students must be able to work independently on a computer.
3. Students must be able to follow all rules and regulations of the program.

Advantages of Credit Recovery

1. Credit Recovery is an independent self-directed learning environment without homework.
2. Credit Recovery is more manageable and a less expensive alternative to correspondence courses and summer school class.
3. Students will be able to earn more credits and also be promoted through extended learning time outside the regular school hours.

How Do I Apply?

Complete the Application (available from school counselor).

Have the teacher of the class you failed complete the "List of Skills to Recover".

Have your parents sign the Contract.

Return your application and your course fee to your counselor.

What Is Credit Recovery?

Credit Recovery is an option for students who have failed a basic high school course with a grade no lower than 63%.

Students wishing to participate in Credit Recovery will be given the opportunity to master skills that they were unable to master during regular class time.

Courses are offered with the use of technology, providing students the individual instruction, skill, and practice they need to master these skills.

Credit Recovery will not replace the failing grade on the student's transcript, but will be shown similarly to a repeated course. The maximum grade that may be recovered is 83%.

Talk with your School Counselor to see if you qualify for Credit Recovery!


Program Eligibility


1. Eligibility: Any student in grades 9 – 12 who has failed or received no-credit with a minimum score of 63%.
2. Participation is based on availability of coursework that might be needed for recovery of credit.
3. Priority for enrollment: Enrollment in this program will be first based on the highest grade level of any school configuration; i.e. seniors, juniors, sophomores, freshmen. First-come, first-served with paid fees


When Will The Credit Recovery Be Offered?

CR opportunities will be offered at your school and scheduled before, after or during regular school hours.


What Else Should I Know?


 The application process must be completed by the Student and the School. All paperwork (Application, Contract, and List of Skills to Recover) must be complete with signatures.


 The student must submit all paperwork and pay fees prior to any work being assigned.

 The student must pay the following fee priors to beginning any coursework.

- 1/2 credit - \$35.00
- 1 credit - \$50.00

 A+ Coursework may begin on the computer. Students will complete work according to standards established by CR staff. Upon completion, student transcripts will be updated with graduation information.

 Students will be supervised by Robertson County Schools' Teachers and Staff.

 Specific details will be outlined in the Student's Contract for Credit Recovery. This may include specific timelines in which to complete work.
